P-EBT is for children who received SNAP food benefits for March 2020 <u>and for children</u> who are certified for free or reduced-price school meals during the 2019-20 Texas school year. Send June 16:

There are two weeks left to apply for P-EBT food benefits. You should have received a school email or letter with a link to the application. Send June 23:
