


Cashier Instructions for Seamless Summer Feeding Program

The cashier will go into serving meals just like always to the meal serving screen (**FS-02-01**), but will select meal type **F** for breakfast meal, **Q** for snack meal, or **M** for lunch meal. When the clerk selects one of the before mentioned meal types it will allow the clerk to serve a reimbursable meal to anyone by simply pressing the "**G**" key at STUDENT ID: ***** prompt on the meal serving screen. The "**G**" key (under the Seamless Summer Feeding Program) will be use a generic account and allow the clerk to serve multiple meals as shown on the screen below. . You can also use the "A" key to serve adults that could be a part of the program in some instances.
